FTA Updates

FY 2010 Appropriations

- Full Allocation tables and FY 2010 Earmarks published May 13, 2010 in Federal Register
- Region IV deadlines for complete grant applications requiring DOL in TEAM:
 - June 30, 2010
- Region IV deadlines for complete grant applications not requiring DOL in TEAM:
 - July 30, 2010





FTA Updates

Transportation Authorization

- SAFETEA-LU expired on Sept. 30, 2009
- Hiring Incentive to Restore Employment (HIRE) Act extended funding to Dec. 31, 2010
- Next Authorization to focus on livability, sustainability and performance-based investments
- Coordinated Planning Programs?





FTA Updates

Discretionary Programs (FTA, OST)

- Bus Livability/Urban Circulator – pending
- Clean Fuels Program - \$81.2M – closed 6/14
- State of Good Repair - \$775M – closed 6/18
- Transit in the Parks Program - \$25M – due 6/28
- Alternatives Analysis Program - \$25M – due 7/12
- TIGGER2 - \$75M – due 8/11
- TIGER2 (OST) - \$600M – pre-applications due 7/16, final due 8/23





FTA Updates

ARRA Planning Update

- No ARRA Amendments allowed after September 30, 2010
- No ARRA Amendments = No ARRA TIP/STIP Amendment Requests
- FTA Grantees have until September 30, 2015 to draw down ARRA funds
- Limited Budget Revisions will be allowed
- ARRA Grants will be closely managed until closeout
